

NORTH KERRY SHOOTING AFFRAY

The three victims of the Kilmorna ambush were brought in coffins from Tralee to Listowel on Saturday evening by the 6 o'clock train, and conveyed to the mortuary chapel, St Mary's Church, where they remained overnight until the following afternoon, when they were removed for burial to their native districts. The following are the names of the deceased young men: Patrick Dalton, Athea; Patrick Walsh, Coolard; Jerh. Lyons, Duagh.

Previous to the arrival at Listowel of the train bearing the corpses of the deceased the blinds of windows and doors of houses on the way to the railway station were drawn and closed, but the police immediately after compelled them to raise their blinds and re-open the doors on penalty of having them burst in forcibly. At short intervals the three coffins were removed in hearses to their respective districts, each accompanied by large numbers of sympathisers, friends and relatives
