

THE KILMORNA AMBUSH

IDENTITY OF THE THREE VICTIMS.

The names of the 3 victims of what is officially described as the Kilmorna ambush, which occurred at Kilmearney, 5 miles from Listowel, are:—

Patrick Dalton, Athea, until recently a hardware assistant in Listowel.

Jeremiah Lyons, son of Mr. J. Lyons, Duagh; and

Patrick Walsh, farmer's son, Coolard.

The bodies were taken to Listowel, and thence to Tralee. There is no confirmation of the report that prisoners were made on the occasion.

The bodies were brought back to Listowel and conveyed to St. Mary's Church for the night. They were then taken to their different districts for interment. On their arrival at Listowel all houses on the route to the church closed the doors and drew the blinds, but were ordered by Crown forces to open their doors on penalty of having them broken in. There was a large attendance of sympathisers at each of the funerals.
